#### hingashi Water Regeneration Cente part of Tokyo Bureau of Sewerage

Works with Ukima Water Regeneration Center to process sewerage from most of the areas of Itabashi, Nerima, and Suginami, and part of Nakano, Kita, Toshima, and Shinjuku. The processed water is discharged to Shingashi River and the all generated polluted sludge are incinerated. Usually it is a no-go facility, but walk-through tours are available on reservation basis. #### Tokumaruhara and Shuhan Takashima

During the Edo period, Takashimadaira, Misono and Shingashi areas were called Tokumaruhara and it was a land of rice paddy and feeder fields. The area started out as a shogunate falconry but later used as a gunnery practicing place. In May 1841, the first Western-style gunnery practice took place here led by Shuhan Takashima, the chief town officer from Nagasaki. Shuhan was based in the Bentenzuka neighborhood (where Shin-takashimadaira Sta. is today) and led the armed soldiers of




